God is still saving:

During this time of Coronavirus, we have not been able to hold church services like normal, but that doesn't mean God isn't working. These 2 young men followed me to church after I gave them a tract on the road. After we had the chance to sit down and I explained the gospel and **they both made decisions to accept Christ as their personal savior.** Praise the Lord, He is still in control and he is still at work!



The government here has put **restrictions on gathering for worship**, so we have had to be a little creative to continue the ministry. At first, we split the church into many small groups and held about 7-8 services per Sunday but when the government rolled-out further restriction we had to come up with another plan. Now we are recording our **preaching and loading the messages on solar panel MP3 players to give to the church members.** This has been a blessing to see because many have been able to listen to the preaching with family and neighbors that have never come to church when invited. God is using this to get the gospel to those who might have never come to our church.

One year ago **I baptized Germain on Easter Sunday.** He and his family quickly became our close friends. His wife, Awa, mentioned to me that he was sick, so I visited him because I had not seen him for a while. I found that he was much sicker than we had realized. I took him to the doctor and found out **he had an infection in his heart and kidney failure. Germain died that same week** leaving behind his wife and 4 children. For his burial, I preached the same message I preached on Easter, Because of the resurrection of Christ we have hope. We truly never know when our life could be over.
