### **Important Furlough Announcement:**

We arrived in Burkina in 2018 with 2 main objectives: to learn the French language; and to learn culture and ministry from veteran missionary Keith Shumaker. We worked hard on learning the language well enough to properly minister here in this country. Then worked alongside Bro Keith Shumaker to learn from his years of experience ministering here in Burkina. He allowed me to pastor his church for 6 months while he was on furlough and then sent me to help The Bread of Life Baptist Church that was currently without a pastor. We have now completed our first term and are ready to go out and start our first church here in Burkina Faso.

We will be taking a short furlough to raise some additional support to keep up with our growing family and ministry. Then we will be coming back to Burkina to start a new church in Zinguedesse. Since we will be taking a short furlough, we will not have time to visit all of our supporting churches. If any of our supporting churches would like us to come by and give an update please let me know because our calendar will fill up quickly.
