Thank you so much to all who gave to support the land purchase for Maranatha Baptist church. God provided all the funds and now we are just working out the final details of the purchase. We will let you know soon once the purchase is officially made. The Church is doing well, and we are seeing steady growth. I have been teaching a church constitution to the men as we prepare to officially organize the church soon.

The months of **March, April, and May** are the **hottest months of the year** for us here in Burkina. Temps reach over 110° consistently for those 3 months and there isn't much you can do to escape the heat. Even at night, it stays in the high 80s to low 90s. Despite the heat, we stay busy as we are trying to take advantage of the longer days. Please pray our family stays healthy during the heat season.
